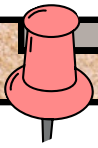

## Week 3

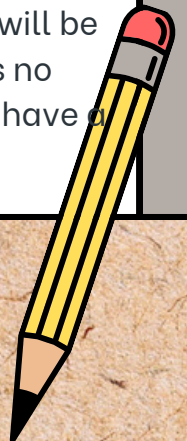
