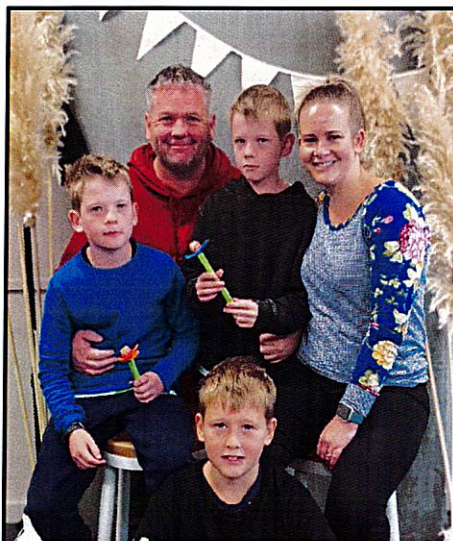
Announcing our new principal –
